- A PhD or relevant post-graduate degree in relevant field.
- Demonstrated experience in teaching political science coupled with a passion for teaching.
- Some experience teaching American undergraduate students or familiarity with American education systems will be helpful.
- Evidence of positive student evaluations from prior teaching experiences.
- Relevant publication record or academic interest in relevant field will be desirable.
- The ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with academic and administrative staff and efficient management of grading, attendance and student queries will be essential.
- Proven ability to work collaboratively
- Ability to work within a VLE and use other technical learning tools.

Faculty are responsible for all aspects of module preparation, teaching and assessment. Flexibility in scheduling is essential. The fall semester runs from 9 September to 12 December, with a midterm break 21-25 October. Applicants must be legally eligible to work in the UK. These are sessional fixed-term contracts for services and not employment. Candidates must be registered, or be able to register, as self-employed in the UK.
